NVQ Level 2 assessment in Dry lining (to qualify for this course you must be working in the dry lining industry and have sufficient experience to meet the NVQ requirements)

WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

The Apprenticeship scheme is designed for candidates to gain employment and earn a wage alongside experienced staff and gain job specific experience skills. You as an apprentice will also be given a one day release receiving training with Chase Tiling Academy and South Staffordshire College to work towards nationally recognized qualifications.

The Apprenticeship can take between one and two years to complete depending on the ability



WALL AND FLOOR TILING APPRENTICESHIP

An apprenticeship in wall and floor tiling allows you to gain on the job training in a work placement, within 18 months you will achieve the following units for the construction award diploma level 2 and NVQ Level 2 in wall and floor tiling.

Diploma Units

- How to carry out safe working practices in construction
- How to prepare backgrounds for tiling
- How to tile floor surfaces
- How to tile wall floor surfaces
- How to form sand and cement screeds

PLASTERING APPRENTICESHIP

An Apprenticeship in Plastering allows you to gain on the job training in a work placement, within 18 months you will achieve the following units for the Diploma Level 2 and NVQ Level 2 in Plastering.

Diploma Units:

- How to carry out safe working practices in construction
- How to apply plaster materials to internal surfaces
- How to apply plaster materials to external surfaces
- How to fix dry lining products to interiors
- How to produce plaster components
- How to position and secure plaster components

and skills required for the industry sector. As an employee you are entitled to a minimum wage of £95 per week however many apprenticeships earn significantly more.

Whilst on the apprenticeship with Chase Tiling Academy and South Staffordshire College you will work towards an NVQ Level 2 and Diploma Level 2 in either Wall and floor tiling or Plastering. Both schemes are completed in approximately 18 months.

Competition for places with employers can be fierce , so you will need to show that you are committed and aware of your responsibilities to both yourself and the company.

NVQ Units:

- VRO1 Conform to general workplace safety
- VR02 Conform to efficient work practices
- VR03 Move and handle resources
